Course Description: Students will be provided with face-to-face training on both the theoretical and practical components of the course.

Assessment comprises of short answer, multiple choice & true/ false questions, and a practical assessment.

On successful completion of the course, participants will be able to competently:

- Identify hazards & risks in the construction industry
- Understand incidents & emergencies
- Identify a range of safety signs
- Understand & wear a range of PPE
- Complete a basic form/workplace documentation.

Outcome: Upon successful completion of this course, participants receive a Statement of Attainment for CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry. WorkSafe will issue the nationally recognised “White Card”

RPL/ Credit Transfer: You may apply for credit transfer and recognition of prior learning; however, Go Workplace Training can only accept evidence where it is obtained in compliance with legislative requirements. As such, it is unlikely that recognition of prior learning will be granted where students provide evidence of having worked in construction sites without completing the training as required by legislation. Credit Transfer is available for an equivalent unit of competency.

Employment and learning pathways: Learning pathway: Once CPCWHS1001 unit is attained, graduates have the option to pursue either the WorkSafe approved 5-day OHS Course (Health and safety representative training) or the Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety or other courses relevant to the construction industry.

Employment pathway: With a white card (obtained from WorkSafe), graduates can secure employment opportunities in various industries such as building, construction, mining, and related fields.
