

RIIWH5204E - Work safely at heights

Duration: 8 hours (may vary, depending on class size, student needs and student experience)

Location: Go Workplace Training (RTO: 22464) has training venues in Dandenong South, Clayton and Williamstown in Victoria. We also offer this course onsite; using GWPT specially designed Trailer.

Dress Requirements: Closed-toed shoes

Equipment Required: When this course is conducted at a GWPT facility, GWPT supplies all equipment required, including PPE. For on-site training, Go Workplace Training will provide you a list of equipment required at the time of enquiry to ensure that your site has all equipment required for the training and assessment of this unit.

Material Required: Go Workplace Training provides all other material including Learner Guide, workbook, reference materials, assessment paperwork and administrative documentation.

GWPT Selection Criteria:

- Candidates must be at least 15 years of age.
- Can use the English language at a level that enables the safe performance of work at heights. Students must also be able to understand the provided texts; comprehend the training in a classroom environment and be able to respond to short answer questions in English. A sample of the text and example of short answer questions are available on request. We recommend that all participants complete a Learning, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment at the time of booking, and to discuss any specific learning needs at this time.

If the LLN test is not returned during the period outlined in the Confirmation Email, and the participant is assessed during the course as not meeting the LLN requirements of the course, the full Course Fee remains payable.

- Participants are required to have general good health and fitness and any pre-existing medical conditions that will affect the training must be disclosed prior to attending.
- The harnesses used in this course are of a standard size. If a participant may need a smaller or larger sized harness, please discuss this with Go Workplace Training at the time of booking.

Course Description: Students will be provided with face-to-face training on both the theoretical and practical components of the course.

Assessment comprises of short answer questions, and practical assessments.

On successful completion of the course, participants will be able to competently:

- Check all safety equipment
- Plan their work
- Use the safety equipment, and move safely at heights
- Pack up equipment at end of shift
- Apply a working knowledge of the OH&S and regulatory requirements.

Outcome: Upon successful completion of this course, participants receive a Statement of Attainment for RIIWHS204E Work safely at heights

RPL/ Credit Transfer: Credit Transfer is available for an equivalent unit of competency.
Prospective students may apply for recognition of prior learning; however, Go Workplace Training can only accept evidence where it is obtained in compliance with legislative requirements.

Employment Pathways: Students who successfully complete this unit will be prepared to work in operational roles across various sectors, including logistics, plumbing, city councils, emergency management services, building maintenance, water boards, agriculture, and construction, which require working at heights.

Learning Pathways: Students who satisfactorily complete this course may consider undertaking other nationally recognised courses in logistics, construction, civil infrastructure or similar areas such as operating elevating work platforms, scaffolding and other licence courses.
