

EWPA Yellow Card

Course Name: EWPA Yellow Card

Company Responsible for Course: The EWPA Yellow Card is a duty of care course. Go Workplace Training conducts this course on behalf of the EWPA.

For an additional fee, students may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to obtain the nationally recognised unit, RIIHAN301E Operate Elevating Work Platform. In this circumstance, the RTO responsible for assessing the unit of competency is Industry Compliant Training (TOID 40825). If you would like to apply for a Statement of Attainment, please speak with your trainer on the day. They will assist you with the required information.

Duration: 6 – 8 Hours (Depending on student numbers and categories)

Location: We have training venues in Dandenong South and Williamstown and offer this training course onsite

Dress Requirements: Closed toed shoes. For on-site training, as per site requirements.

Equipment Required: When the course is conducted at a Go Workplace Training facility, all equipment (including PPE is provided). For on-site training, a list of equipment is provided at the time of enquiry to ensure that the site meets all requirements for training and assessment to take place.

On the day of training, you will be required to undertake a pre work assessment (PWA) before participating in your Yellow Card course and access your EWPA Learner Portal. Please ensure you have a mobile or desktop device (with internet capability, a camera) and a device charger for this purpose.

Training Materials Required: All training materials are provided, including a Participant Guide, videos, resource materials, assessment paperwork, and administrative documentation. The training materials are provided for your reference only and must be returned to your trainer/assessor at the end of the workshop day.

Entry Requirements: Participants must be at least 16 years of age. Students under 18 years of age must have a completed and signed EWPA Parent/Guardian Consent Form submitted prior to the commencement of training. This form will be attached to your booking confirmation email. NO minor is to start or complete any Yellow Card training or assessment without a signed parent and guardian consent form.

Basic verbal and written English communication skills sufficient to read material and understand instruction [students will undertake a pre work assessment (PWA) on the workshop day under supervision before participating in the Yellow Card course.]

Participants are required to have general good health and fitness and any pre-existing medical conditions that will affect the training must be disclosed prior to attending. Participants must be confident to work at heights and appropriately fit and healthy to undertake physically demanding work.

Evidence of identity

You must have a government issued photo identification to satisfy age and identity. Your ID must be **CURRENT** and show:

- full name
- photograph
- date of birth
- signature
- current address (not required for passport)

A birth certificate would **NOT** be accepted ID as it would not have a photo, signature or a current address. Drivers licence, passport, Proof of Age card are all acceptable documents if they are current. Passports do not have a current address so a secondary piece of identity must also be provided with these details.

Course Description:

Participants will be able to identify the specific type of equipment, plan their work, operate the equipment, and safely shut down the equipment.

Outcome:

Successful participants are issued with **digital** EWPA - EWP Operator Licence Yellow Card
